


■ Elliot Smith's latest CD offers emotional tunes reminiscent of The Beatles

as one of the greatest songwriters of his generation. Smith was quickly swept up from the glowing embers of indie rock and maverick label Kill Rock Stars, to become soundtrack-boy for the major label DreamWorks. The result was 1998's lush "XO", and Smith fans embraced his clearly ironic, newfound rock-star persona because, well, it actually worked.

With "Figure 8," Smith continues with his bigger, more extroverted sound, but brings back some of the painstakingly person-


