Many world-class expeditions have been arranged through the program, including climbing the Himalayas, bicycling through South America and sea kayaking in exotic waters off Thailand. Numerous weekend hiking, rafting, skiing and climbing trips are launched by participants seeking adventure closer to home.

Trips are initiated by the participants, and the only cost is the actual shared expenses for the trip. The program has a wide variety of equipment available for minimal rental costs.

The Outdoor Program also sponsors on-campus events and its Wilderness Resources Center has extensive information about the outdoors.
