If there is a VCR available, use it. It could be another 103 years before a game like this blows through the state again.

This, the 104th edition of the fabled Civil War, is the most anticipated, most hyped and most important Oregon vs. Oregon State

battle ever.

Sure, there were previous wars that had serious postseason implications, but never have both teams entered the game ranked among the top-10 teams in the na-

tion, along with having legitimate Rose Bowl hopes.

The game, which kicks off at 12:30 p.m. Saturday at Reser Stadium in Corvallis, is always the main event in the state of Oregon, but this one tops the charts.

After all, Oregon (9-1 overall, 8-0 Pacific-10 Conference) must simply win and it goes to the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, Calif., for only the fifth time in school history.

Oregon State (9-1, 6-1), meanwhile, must win and then hope Washington State defeats Washington in the 3:30 p.m. Apple Cup to give the Beavers their first smell of roses since 1965.

It's enough to divide a few households for at least a week.

"I don't think there are many people in this state who are neutral," Oregon quarterback Joey Harrington said. "You're either a Duck or a Beaver. I don't think there's much
