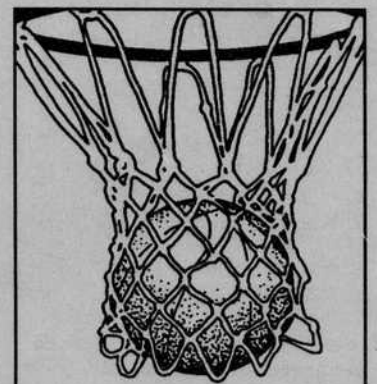


The other side of baroque music
