

# PROMO PHOTO OF THE WEEK

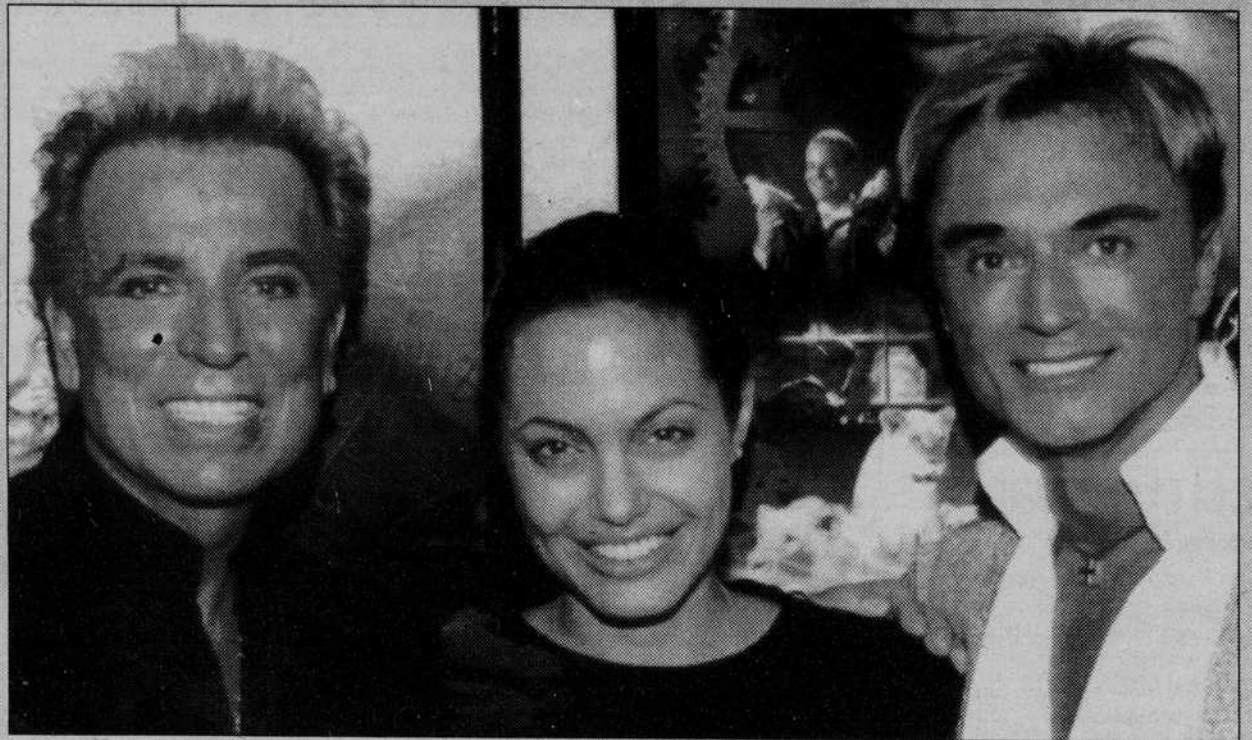
