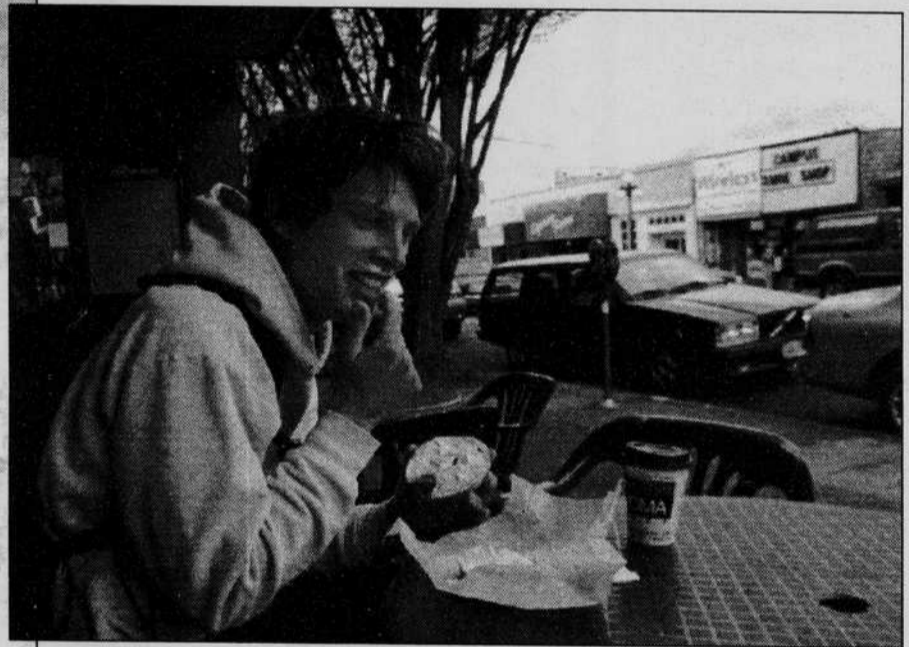
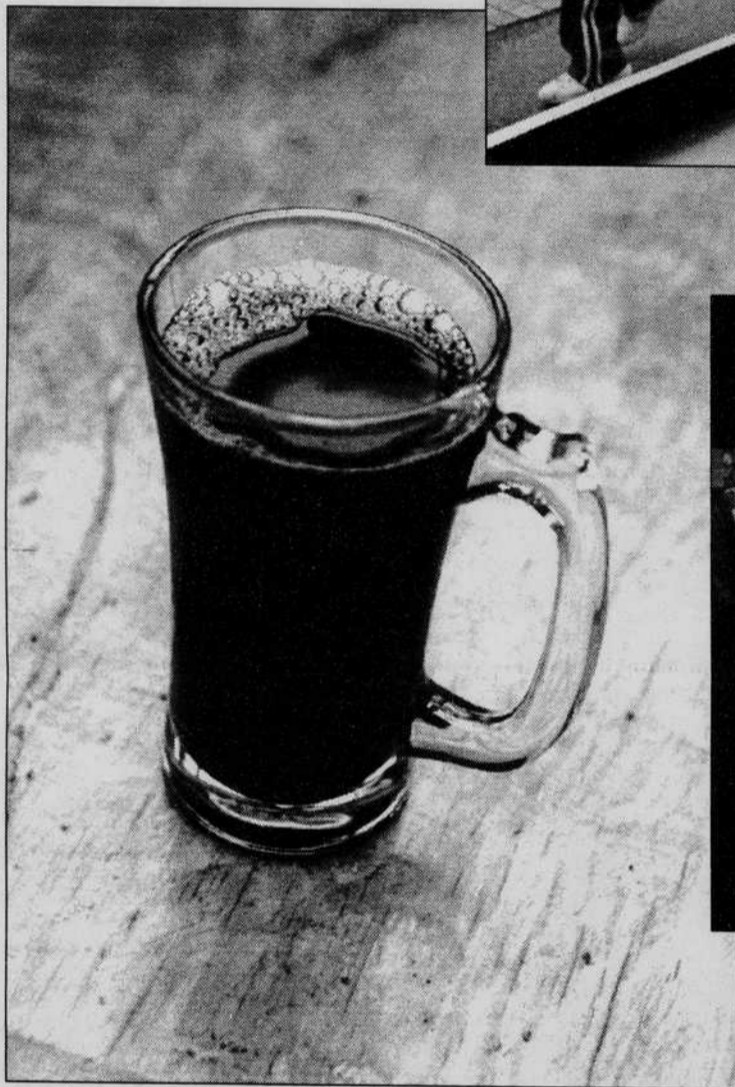


# Local flavor
