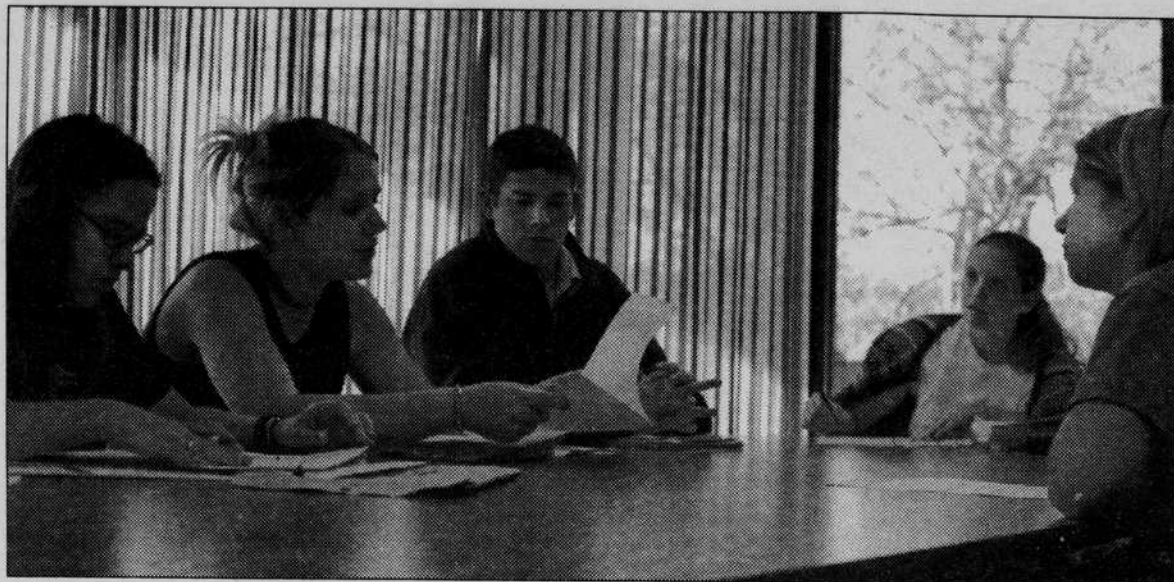

Ben Buzbee, their year as ASUO Executive is just beginning.

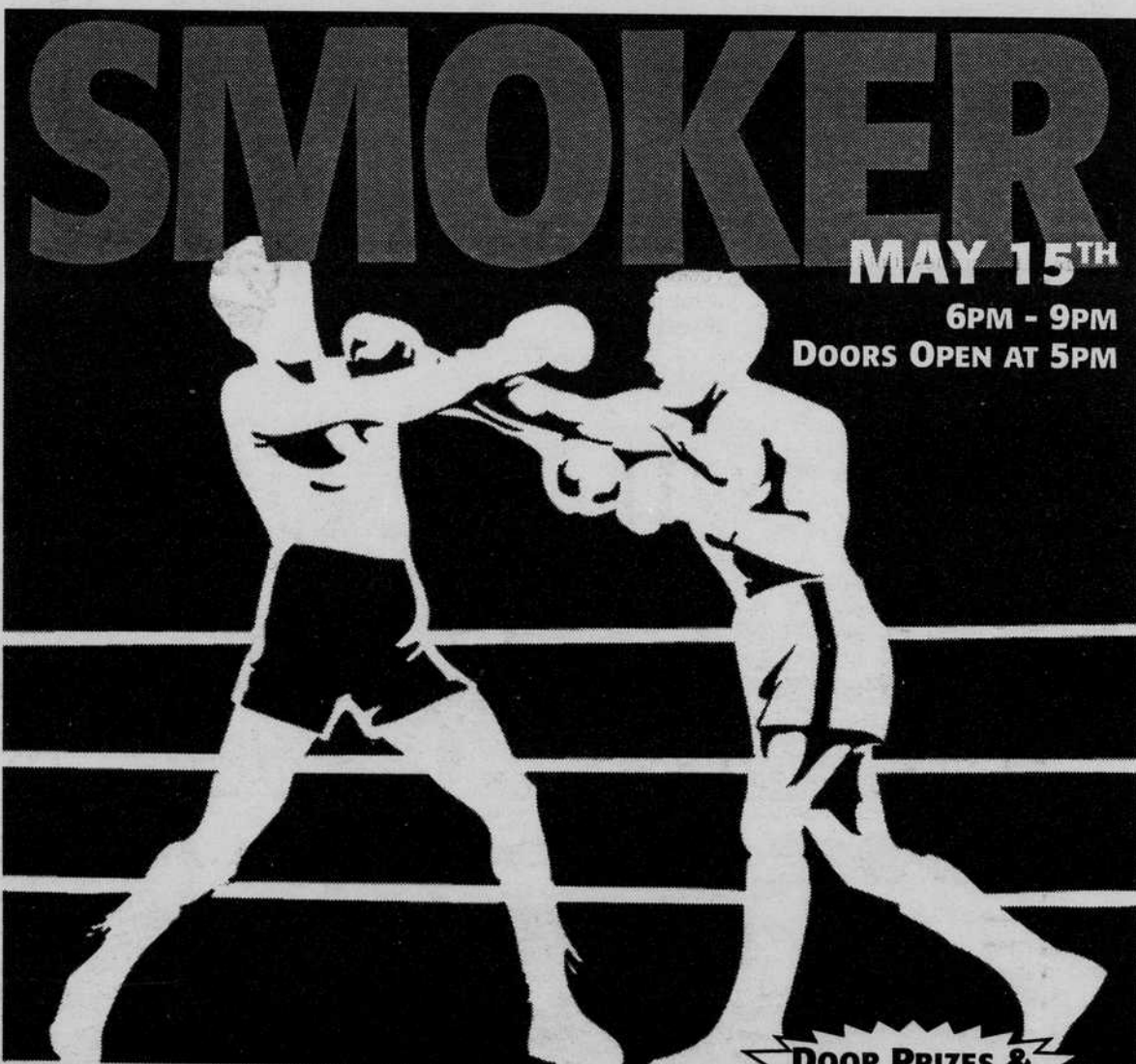
Pilliod and Buzbee will take the helm of ASUO president and vice president, respectively, from Nilda Brooklyn and Joy Nair officially May 25.
