The dessert selections are specially

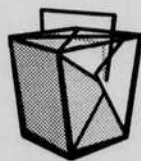
made for Willie's by a renowned local dessert chef. We chose the Oreo cheesecake along with the seven-layer chocolate torte. They were both to die for.
