Defense doesn't always win the game

When the season began, Oregon couldn't miss.

The two 100-plus point killings in exhibition games established the Ducks as an offensive powerhouse.

But lately, Oregon has found itself in a slump and can't seem to find the hoop. The Ducks haven't managed to put 50 points on the board since the loss to Green Bay on Tuesday the 26th.

The Ducks have lost the point margin 200-140, including the game against Wisconsin and in the Paradise Jam.

"We are not making our shots," Edwards said. "We have gotten down on ourselves a couple of times, we just need to keep on shooting the ball because that is the only way you are going to score the points."

Oregon is averaging 55.8 points per game this season, far below last season's average of 68.4.
