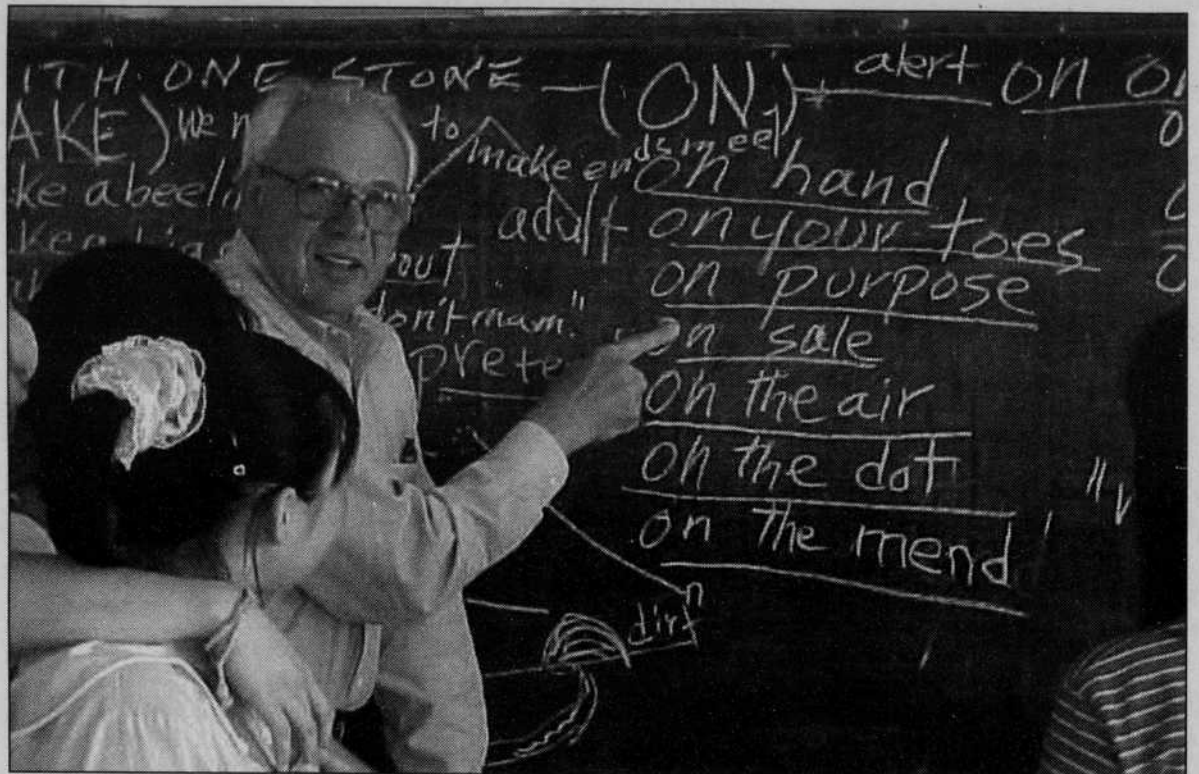

lot different than what you're used to can be a character-building experience," said Szekeley, who has visited China twice.


Former Lane County Commissioner Jerry Rust said he enjoyed teaching in China and is now trying to inspire others to stand the lectern overseas.


