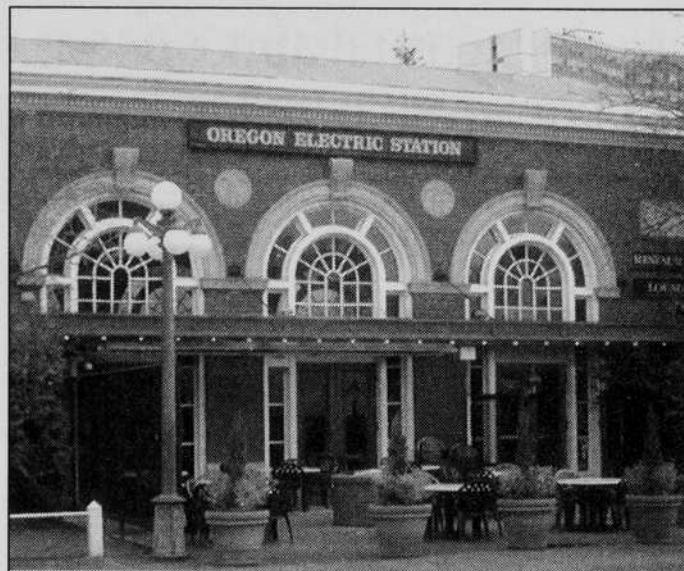

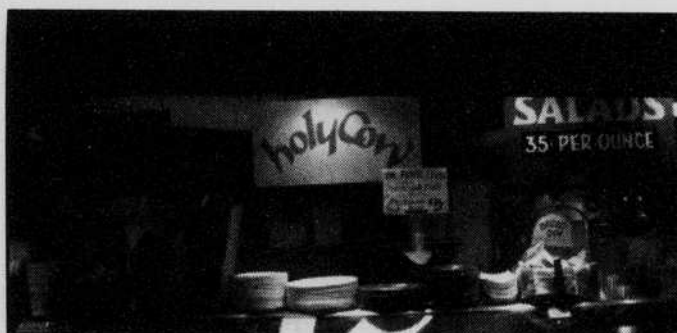

We decided to start our dinner with the steamed clams and sautéed mushrooms. The steamed clams and mushrooms served by our waiter were absolutely delicious. The clams were drenched in garlic, butter and wine sauce and we devoured them, filling an entire bowl with empty shells.
