The Ducks and Beavers swept Washington in Seattle for the first time in Pac-10 history, beginning with the Beavers' win Friday, continuing with Oregon's 6-5 win Saturday and ending with the Ducks' 6-5 win Sunday.

Washington (40-13-1 overall, 7-11 Pac-10) is 2-8 in its last 10 games. Two days before losing to the Beavers, the Huskies also lost to No. 2 UCLA.
