"All of our mishaps are from love," he said.

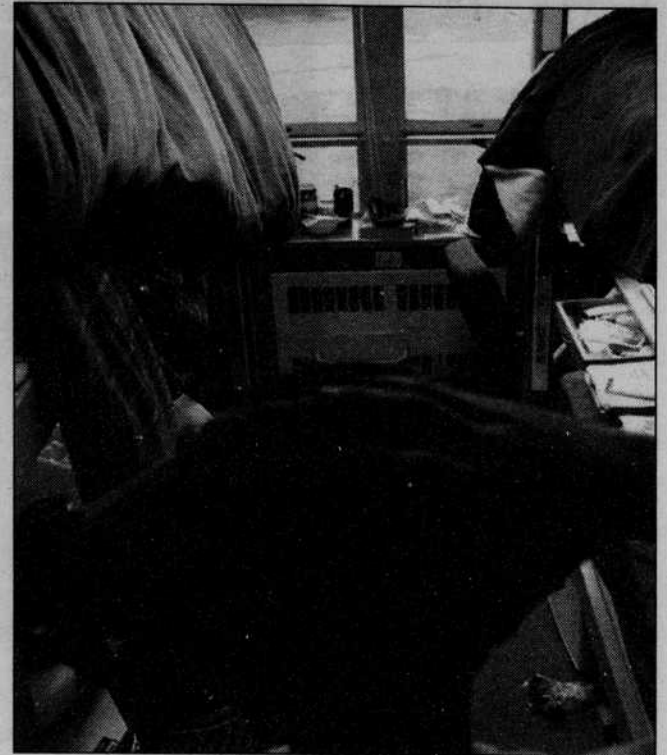
Junior Greg Bresnitz, who lives in a two-bedroom house, also has a big job on his hands. He said he has not cleaned his roof gutter the whole year.
