What is FPEP?

Family Planning Expansion Project is a federal program providing family planning and birth control services to prevent unintended pregnancy.

FPEP Covered Services & Supplies for Women and Men!

- Annual women's exam combined with contraceptive management
- Sexually transmitted infections screening combined with contraceptive management for men and women
- Birth control for men and women
- Pregnancy testing visit

FPEP Eligibility Requirements

You must be:

- A US citizen, or a lawful permanent resident who has resided in the US for a minimum of 5 years.
- A resident of the State of Oregon.
- A woman 55 years of age or younger or a man of any age.
- Earning a gross monthly income less than or equal to \$1,365.
