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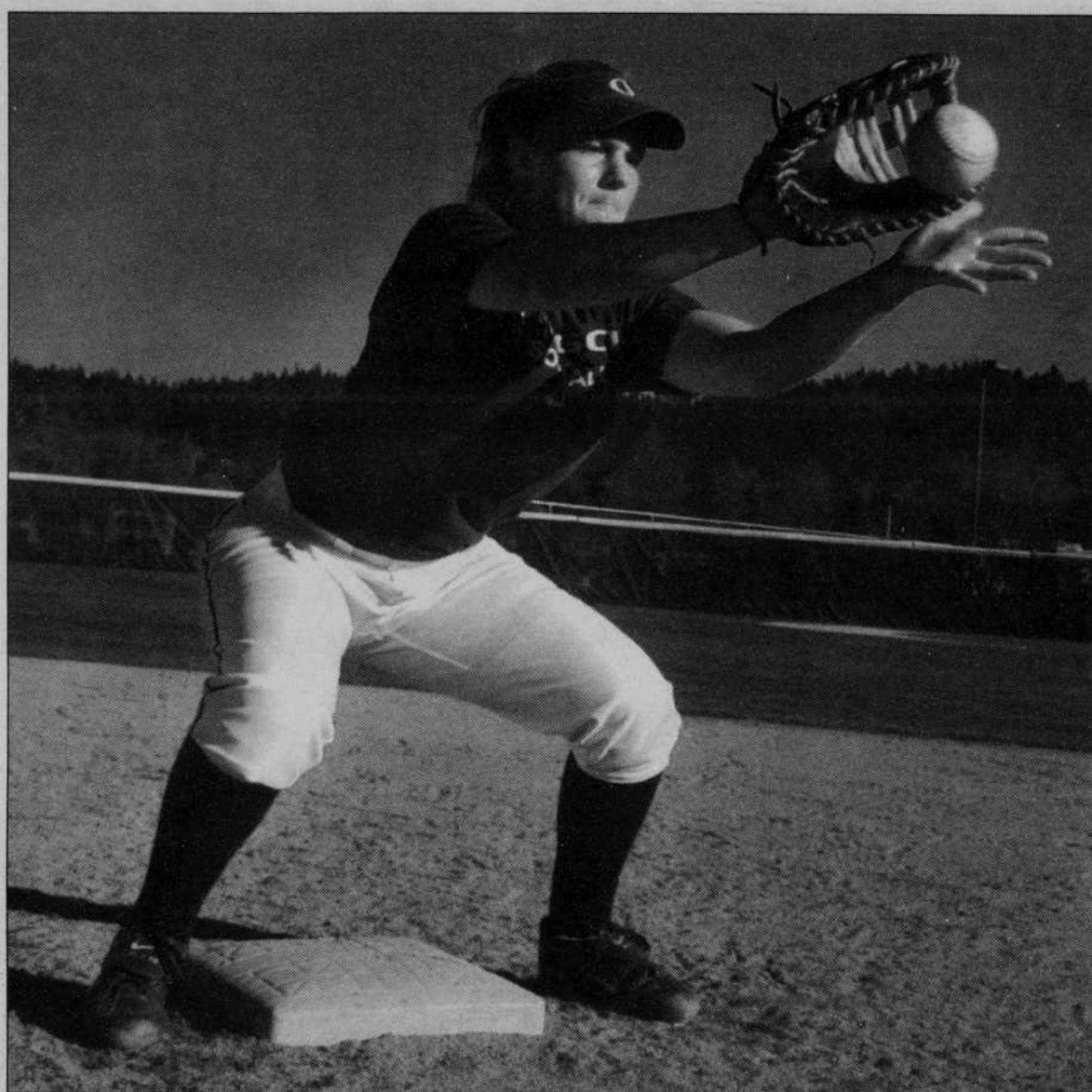

CONSISTENT

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"We're really focusing on getting two wins," Oregon catcher Jenn Poore said. "These are two important wins for us going into the main part of the Pac-10 season. We need these wins for regionals. Regionals isn't a given — we need to make sure that we belong there."

The Vikings are led by senior third baseman Annie Peccia. She leads the PCSC with a .429 batting average and leads Portland State with 14 runs, 33 hits and a .571 slugging percentage. Peccia was named the PCSC Player of the Week Tuesday.

"(The Vikings) have had some very strong performances," Arendsen said. "Portland State will not make mistakes. We're going to have to play well or they won't make the mistakes to allow us in the game. That's going to be our focus that we go out there and play well."

In their seven games at Howe Field during spring break, the Ducks committed 15 errors, including four in each game against Missouri.

Earlier in the season, Arendsen talked about Oregon's successful

defense. While the Ducks have a .955 fielding percentage through Saturday's games, their opponents have a .963 fielding average against Oregon.

"I'd like to see our defense shore up a little bit," Arendsen said. "We've had a lot of errors this last week and it's weird to be at home and have that happen."

The Ducks are currently going through a roller coaster in their season. Despite their 25-9 record, they are 6-4 in their past 10 games, with losses to Utah State, Missouri, Southern Utah and Coastal Carolina. Arendsen thought consistency would be an issue early in the season, but

since Oregon put together a 14-game winning streak, the issue has recently become the Ducks' ability to find a constant rhythm.

"We're looking for consistency," Arendsen said. "We've got to get to the point where every day we're coming out evenly."
