The weather can present a problem for those students who rely on bikes for transportation, but alternate transportation can almost always be found, by way of bus, car or carpool.

Gabe Winfrey, a senior business major, lives in South Eu-

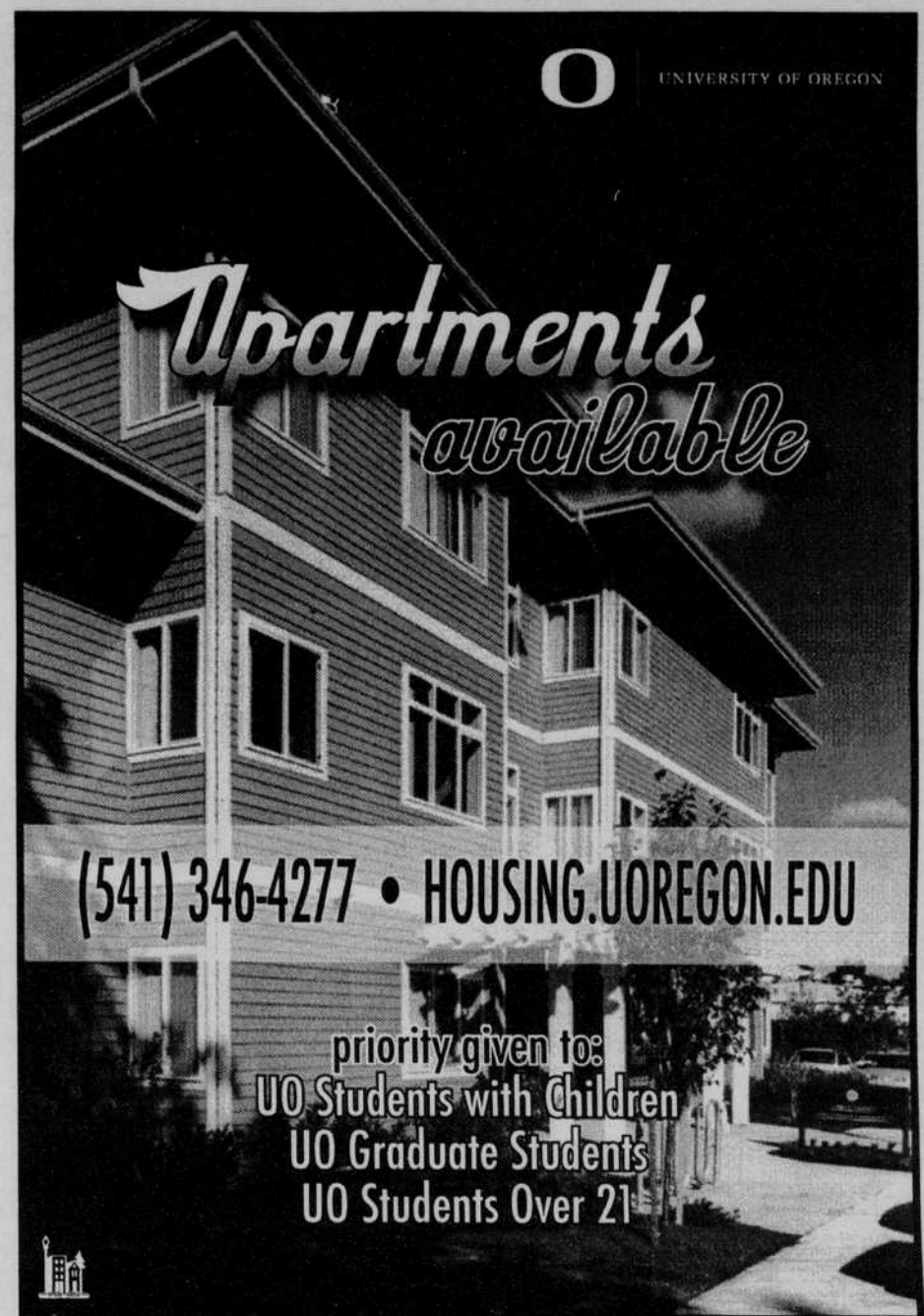
gene on 48th Avenue and Donald Street. He said he would not want to live so far from campus if he didn't have a car.

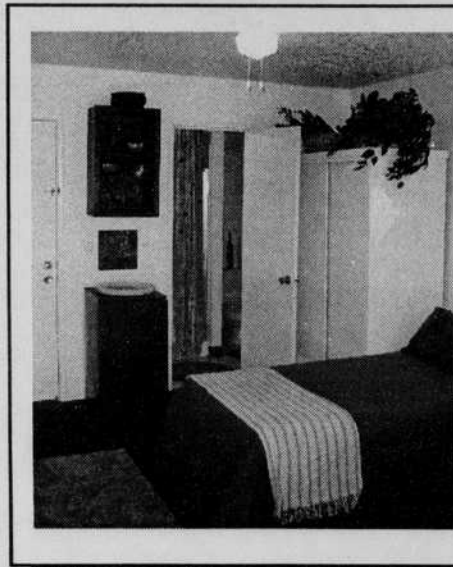
