"If we do that with every team, we're going to be able to win every game," Oregon point guard Corrie Mizusawa said. Mizusawa dished out a game-high nine assists.

Bills and Haring combined for 14 points on eight attempts in the opening half. Haring went 4 of 4 in the first 20 minutes. At halftime, Oregon led 27-21.

"We were a little bit too hesitant in the post in the first half," Smith said. "We just felt that aggression, we didn't post up, and we didn't bury them as deep as we needed to."

Cathrine Kraayeveld had an off-night with only five points for the Ducks, making this the first time she has not scored double-digits this season. However, the senior recorded 10 rebounds, eight defensively.

"Offensively, she wasn't very accurate, but she is more than just a scorer," Smith said. "Some of her greatest qualities are defensive."

Each team committed 21 turnovers in the contest, and Oregon won the battle for points in the paint, 22-12.

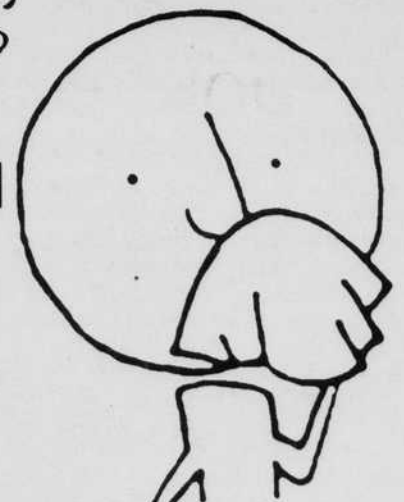
