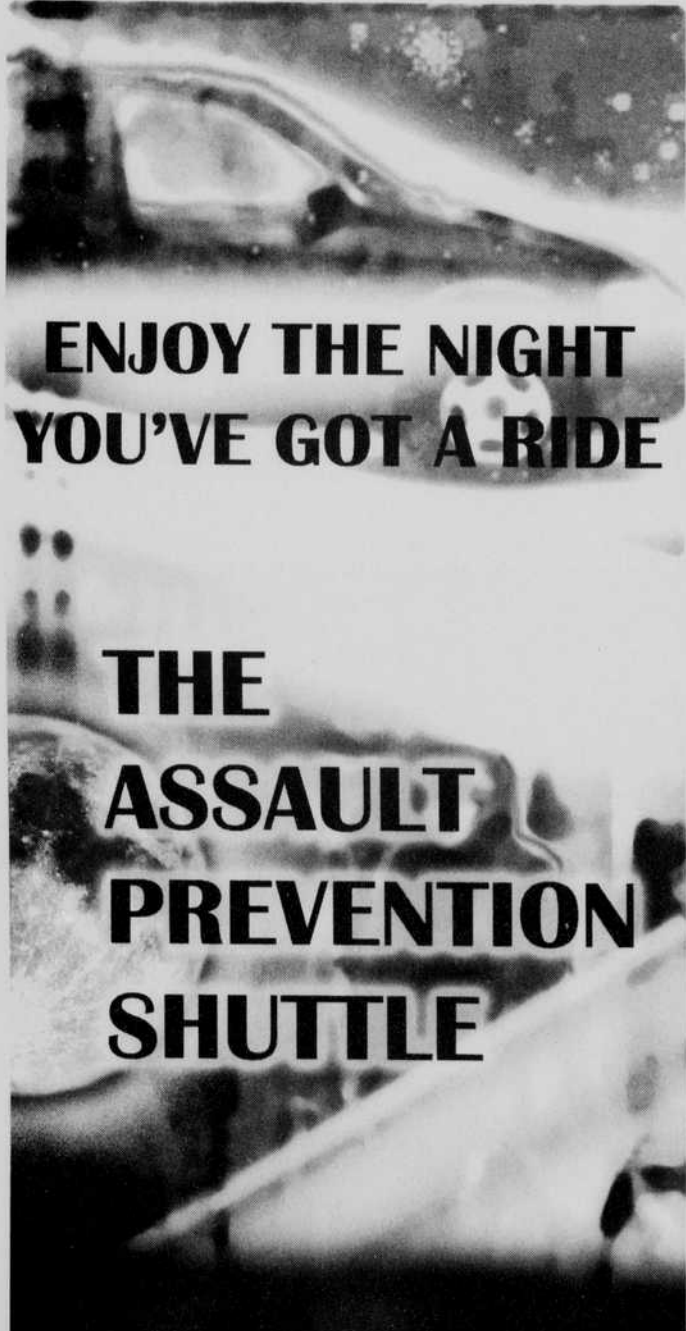

Highlands Brew Pub, true to its name, is located in the hills of south Eugene. While it may be a little way out there, it's definitely worth checking out. Highlands offers over 40 beers on tap, mostly microbrews with the staples, such as Pabst Blue Ribbon, not forgotten. They also rotate a few beers, meaning you can always stop in and try something you probably haven't heard of before. Their specials vary a little with the best on Wednesdays. All appetizers are half-price until 9:00, and pool is free all day on any of their eight tables. The appetizers generally run about \$6, but the half-price Wednesdays make for an

affordable meal of chicken strips and nachos. (Oh, and try the teriyaki wings—real good!) Highlands also offers two big screen TVs as well as other smaller, mounted TVs surrounded by couches and comfortable seating that's perfect for hanging out and watching a game. The crowd typically consists of local neighborhood folks and a smaller college crowd, making for a good mix. A jukebox with an excellent play list, pinball, Ms. Pac Man and video poker complete the casual atmosphere.
