Commons and Duck's Village cater to different student preferences. Duck's Village, at 3225 Kinsrow Ave., has an atmosphere charged with student activity.


With all the students living here, there is always something going on," said Duck's resident Tessa Maurer.


The apartments come fully furnished. Every apartment has central air conditioning and is heated with natural gas. Security patrols at night to ensure safety.
