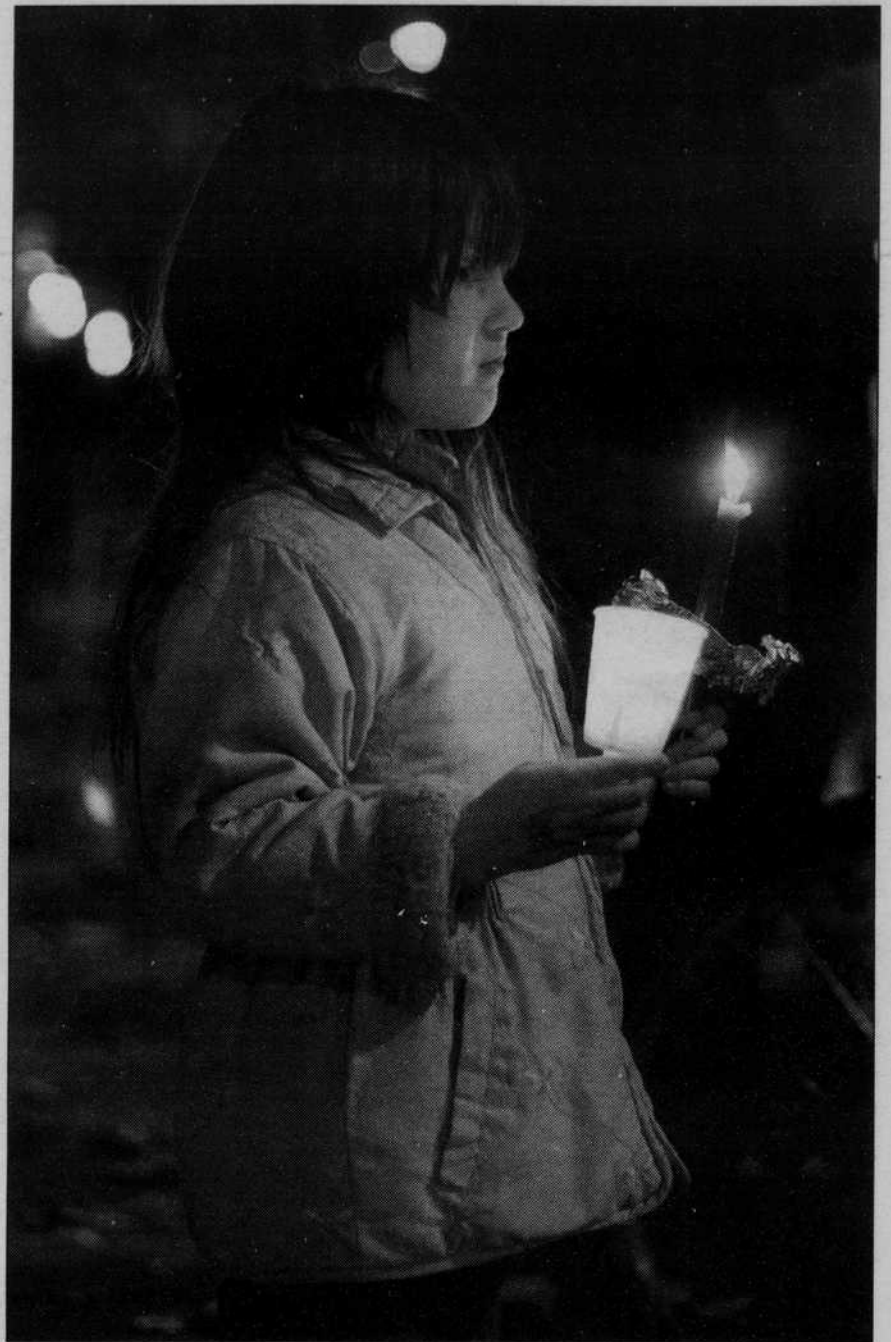
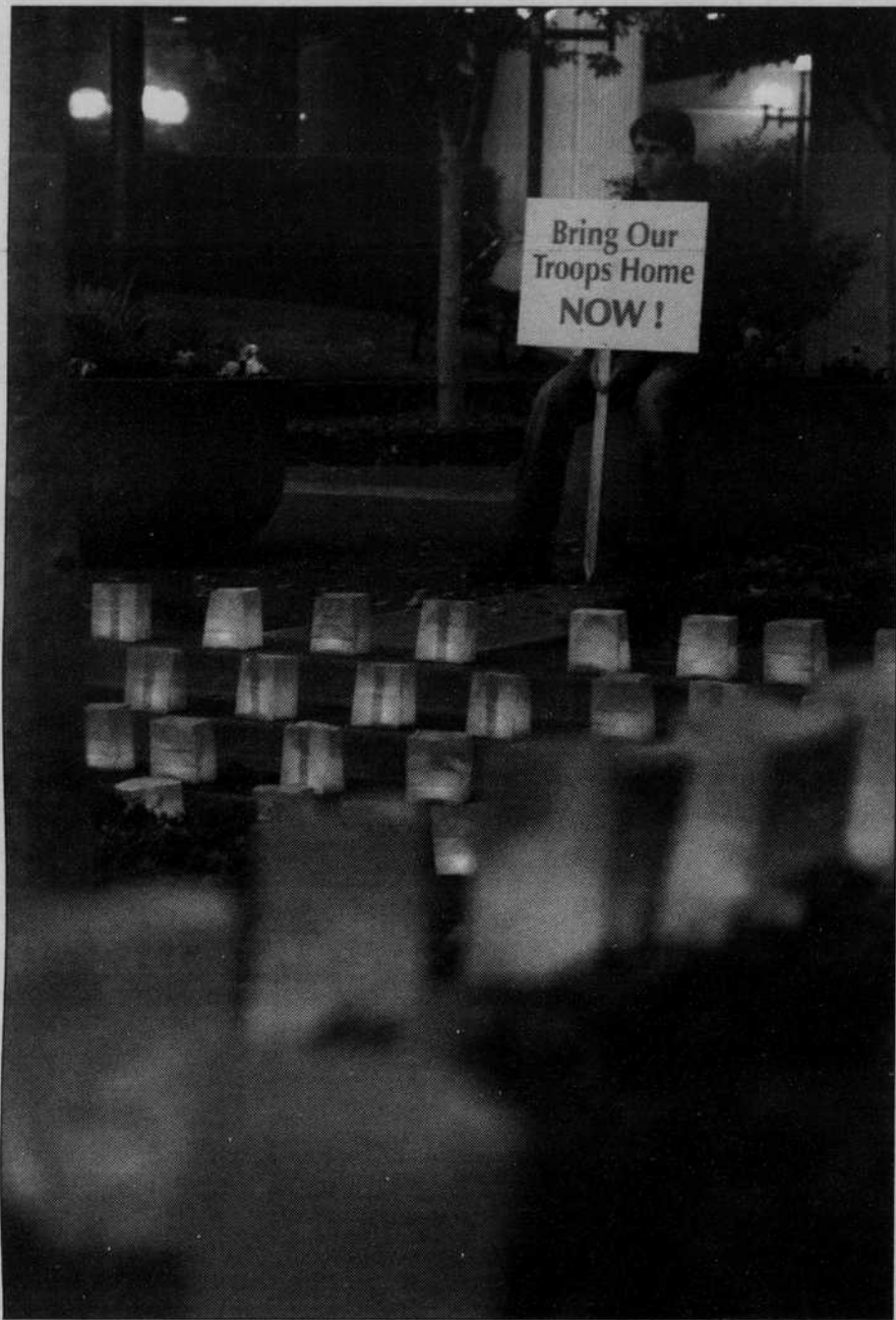


CANDLELIGHT VIGIL HONORS SOLDIERS KILLED IN IRAQ
