ordinance fish, except with hook and line, commonly called angling, from and after 12 o'clock noon on the 15th day of April, 1913, to 12 o'clock noon on the 15th day of May, 1913, and it shall be unlawful to fish for, or take or catch any fish with any device or contrivance, except with hook and line, commonly called angling, in any of said waters during the period of time herein specified.

Any and all persons who violate or fail to observe in violation of this ordinance shall be punished as by law provided. Geo. H. Kelly, Chairman of the Fish and Game Commission, Secretary. C. F. Stone, W. J. Mackie, Consulting geologist, State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners.
