**County Court Proceedings**

Monday, June 16, 1913, 9th judicial day.  
Court came pursuant to call of county judge.  
Officers all present.  
Due proclamation being made the following proceedings were had:  
Matter of Incorporation of Goble, Oregon:

Whereas, at a special election duly and regularly held on the 7th day of June, 1913, within that portion of Columbia County, State of Oregon, described as  
Beginning at a point on the section line between sections 12 and 13, township 6 North, Range 2 West, 30 feet east of the corner common to sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, in Columbia County, Oregon; running thence south 0 deg. 34 min. W. 666.9 feet; thence west 30 feet; thence S. 1 deg. 18 min. E. 120 feet; thence N. 88 deg. 42 min. E. 2664.6 feet; thence S. 85 deg. 58 min. E. 199.4 feet; thence N. 68 deg. 58 min. E. 154.3 feet; thence N. 89 deg. 18 min. E. 984 feet to the western limit of the Seattle, Portland & Spokane Railroad Company's right-of-way; thence on the same course to the center of the main channel of the Columbia river, thence down the center of the main channel of the Columbia River to a point where a line projected N. 83 deg. 27 min. E. from the N. E. corner of said Foster's Town of Goble would intersect said center line; thence S. 83 deg. 27 min. W. to the said N. E. corner of said Foster's Town of Goble; thence on the same course 1178.3 feet, along the N. line of said Foster's Town of Goble; thence S. 6 deg. 33 min. E. 1264.2 feet; thence S. 9 deg. 43 min. the place of beginning, there was submitted to the legal voters thereof the question whether all that said described portion of Columbia County, State of Oregon, should be incorporated as the city of Goble, under and pursuant to the provisions of that certain act of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, passed at its regular session held in 1913, entitled "An act to provide for the organization and incorporation of cities and towns and to legalize such corporations as heretofore have attempted to be incorporated under Chapter 1 of Title XXVI of Lord's Oregon Laws are now exercising the functions of incorporated cities and towns under such attempted incorporation; and  
Whereas, at such election so held 36 votes were cast in favor of such incorporation, and no votes were cast against such incorporation; and  
Whereas, the incorporation of such city of Goble received the affirmative vote of the majority cast at such election; now, therefore, the County Court of Columbia County, State of Oregon, as above described, has been duly and legally incorporated as a municipal corporation, under the corporate name of the City of Goble, under and pursuant to and with the powers vested in such corporation by virtue of chapters 2, 3 and 4 of Title XXVI of Lord's Oregon Laws.  
It is further ordered by the court that on the 30th day of June, 1913, at the polling place in said city of Goble, and within the afore described boundaries, an election be held for electing the following named officers: A Mayor, six aldermen, a recorder, a Marshal and a Treasurer, which election shall be held at eight o'clock in the morning and shall continue until seven in the afternoon of said day.  
It is further ordered by the court that the following named persons be and they are hereby appointed as judges and clerks of said election:  
Judges, J. T. McKiddy and Olive D. Hunter.  
Clerks, W. E. Makinster, F. Stuart and E. Bishop.  
Whereupon, court adjourned until Wednesday, July 2, 1913.
