

From the Eugene section comes the information that while the 1913 prune crop is larger in volume than for years, the fruit ranges relatively small in size. The Eugene evaporating plant is running to full capacity and is putting about 800 ing room every 24 hours. Packing of the dried fruit for shipment will begin in about 10 days. It is stated that an unusually large proportion of the prune crop is being marketed as fresh fruit than ever before, and this fact, in connection with the unfortunate prevalence of state, is expected to result in a marked decrease in the dried product. Early quotations for dried prunes are very attractive, indications pointing to an unusual European demand later in the year. The region around Dallas has this
