#### WEATHER BUREAU SERVES FARMERS

The United States weather bureau has perfected special systems and facilities for obtaining and disseminating advance weather news adapted to the protection of growers of many special crops in different sections of the country. In connection with the weather reports received from its 200 stations and from 4,050 other observation points, the bureau has established a large number of special stations in the corn, wheat, cotton, sugar, rice and cattle raising districts. The object of this service is to furnish the growers of crops throughout the summer with information that will enable them to han die the crops to the best advantage.

Special rain and temperature forecasts for the sheepmen in Oregon, Washington and Idaho were made by the district forecaster at Portland during the sheaing and lambing sea-
