

INDUSTRIAL REVIEW

Cervalls—Work will soon be finished on the new Blodgett road. Oregon City—Work on the Pacific highway is progressing between Cannon and Oregon City and 110 men are employed in the road building. At Roseburg the Churchill warehouse and adjacent grounds have been secured for the Roseburg Cannery company and machinery has been ordered for the new plant which will cost approximately \$10,000. Half a million more sheep and a quarter of a million more cattle will be taken care of on national forests this year. The Newport Red Cross ladies have at 900 pounds of Sphagnum moss for Cervalls. It is the first shipment of this material which will be used for surgical dressings for U. S. soldiers. Medford—A large body of magnesia has been found south of this city and plans are being made to construct a mill. Toledo—Another sawmill has been shipped here and when erected will have a cutting capacity of 50,000 feet per day. Elgin—Galloway Bros., have purchased a 1200 acre tract southeast of here. The purchase price of the tract was \$60,000. Elko—The wool clip of 50,000 pounds has been shipped to Boston. Portland—Steps are to be taken to reclaim 8,000 acres of land along the Columbia slough. Umpqua—Both saw mills here are operating steadily and expect to continue for the remainder of the year. Marshfield—A 5000 ton ship will be built here. Officials of local yard state that next keel laid will be for a vessel of this tonnage. Beaverton—The big brick and tile plant of the Oregon Brick & Tile Co., at this place will be in operation within ten days. The management is getting up men and expects a good crop this summer.

J. D. Hanley, for fill on Hazel Grove Road (Sullivan Hill). And the Court not being fully advised in the matter, it is ordered by the Court that the following named proposals be, and the same are hereby continued: J. D. Hanley, for Erickson Road.

Jess Gravens, for Erickson Road. It is further ordered by the Court that all other bids submitted at this time, be and the same are hereby rejected.

And it appearing to the Court that no bids were submitted for the construction of the Pebble Creek bridge, it is ordered by the Court that said improvement be performed by the County Road-Master under the direction of the Court.

Whereupon Court adjourned until June 5th, 1918.

Wednesday, June 5th, 1918, 6th Judicial Day. Court came pursuant to adjournment, officers all present. Matter of Hanna Oya, County Aid.

On this day it is ordered by the Court that a General Fund Warrant in the amount of \$25.00 be drawn in favor of Hanna Oya as county aid and that a like warrant be drawn on the General Fund on the first day of each and every month hereafter until the further order of the Court.

Matter of Cattle Indemnity. Claim of Burt West. On this 5th day of June 1918, came for hearing the claim of Burt West of Scappoose, Oregon, for indemnity in the sum of \$162.50 for 13 grade cows over the age of two years, slaughtered under the supervision of the State Live Stock Sanitary Board, under chapter 14, general laws of 1913 and it appearing to the Court from the certificates and affidavits filed relating thereto, that said animals were slaughtered on the 10th day of December, 1917, at the Union Meat Co., North Portland, under the supervision of J.
