Certificate of Necessity for Increase in State Tax Levy for 1919 (Issued under authority of Chapter 150, Laws of 1917)

We, the undersigned, constituting the State Tax Commission of Oregon, hereby certify that in our opinion it is necessary to levy an amount of State taxes for the fiscal year 1919 larger by \$940,000.00 than the amount limited by the Constitution of Oregon

Shall the increase of \$940,000.00, as stated in the foregoing certificate, in the total amount of the State levy of taxes for the year 1919 over the amount otherwise limited by the Constitution of Oregon, be authorized?
