And it appearing to the court that the total value of the assessable property of the county of Columbia, Oregon, as appears by the assessment rolls for the year 1920 is the sum of \$13,732,465 for taxation purposes, and that in order to raise the aforesaid amounts, for State, School, and other county purposes as aforesaid, it will be necessary to levy a tax of 21.1 mills upon all the assessable property of the county.

And that in order to raise the aforesaid amounts for General Road and District Road purposes it will be necessary to levy a tax of 10 mills upon all the assessable property of the county as aforesaid.

It is therefore ordered by the court that a levy of 21.1 mills on the dollar be divided as follows:

It is further ordered by the court that a tax levy of 3 mills on the dollar on all the assessable property within the county of Columbia, Oregon, be, and the same is hereby levied for the purpose of "Market Road" construction, as provided for under sections 4680 to 4684 inclusive, Olson's Oregon Laws.

The budget was put to a standing vote of the tax-payers present and was adopted by a vote of 44 to 2.

Matter of Special School Tax Estimated by School Superintendent:

It appearing to the court from the estimates submitted by the County School Superintendent that it will be necessary to levy a special tax in School District No. 6 in accordance with section 259 of the Oregon School Laws; It is therefore ordered by the court that a special school tax is hereby levied upon the property of said School District No. 6 at the rate set opposite said district and being as follows:
