

OCCUPATION OF SIGNERS OF DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

Of the 56 men who signed that immortal document—the Declaration of Independence—24 were lawyers, 13 were farmers, 9 were mechanics, 5 were doctors, 2 were preachers, one was a mariner, one a surveyor. The youngest signer was Edward Rutledge, from South Carolina, who was only 27 years of age.

Contrary to general belief, all of the signatures were not affixed to the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. It was signed on that day by John Hancock, president, and Charles Thompson, secretary.
