#### SCHOOL CENSUS SHOWS AN INCREASE

The school census for School District No. 2 was recently completed. The census shows that there are 537 school children residing in this district. The last census gave the number as 773, so this year's census shows an increase of 64 or about 9 per cent. It is the opinion of County School Superintendent Wilkerson that the next census will show 1,000 school children and that the district will then be designated as a district of the first class.

The heavy rains of the past week are responsible for the more or less muddy water which came through the city water pipes. Charles Lope, superintendent of the system, flushed out the hydrants and waste pipes often and now the water is clear. Mr. Lope stated that at the headwater reservoir, the torrent which came down from the hills filled the reservoir and overflowed the dam. He did all he possibly could to relieve the situation.
