**85,000 TONS OF ARMOR MAY BE DIVERTED**

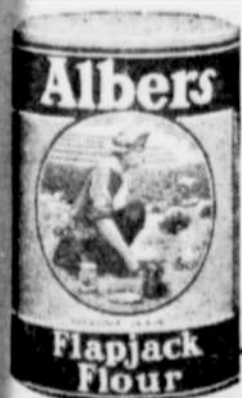
The disposition of 15,000 tons of steel armor plate, purchased at a cost of \$7,500,000 now stacked in the navy yards, is awaiting the final decisions of the armament conference. This steel was purchased from the Bethlehem and Midvale steel plants and the naval ordnance plant at Charleston, West Virginia, for use in the construction of the dreadnaughts "South Dakota" and "Indiana." It is Parveized, varies in thickness from five to twelve inches, and each piece weighs from 60 to 75 tons.

In addition to this steel which has already been delivered to the navy yards where these dreadnaughts are under construction, 70,000 tons of similar armor plate is now going through the steel mills under contract. When this order was placed it was intended to use the steel in the construction of five war vessels being erected in different navy yards as follows: the "West Virginia" and "Iowa" at Newport News; "Montana" at Mare Island, California; "North Carolina" at Norfolk, Virginia, and the "Massachusetts" at Fore River yard, Quincy, Massachusetts.

**\$10,000,000 FOR NEW FREIGHT CARS**

**Union Pacific System Will Build Them All With Lumber From Northwest Mills.**

The Union Pacific system will expend immediately nearly \$10,000,000 for increased freight car equipment, according to announcement yesterday through the local offices. This is among the first announcements of railway expenditures that is of importance to the Pacific northwest.

The contracts which require the expenditure of the money call for the building of 4500 new freight cars for delivery the first six months of this year. The contracts require the use of lumber from this territory to enter into the construction of the cars. Several million feet of fir lumber will be used in building the cars. The railway officials have specified that the car builders who will erect them in the east obtain this lumber from mills on the Union Pacific line in this section.

Of the 4500 cars, 2000 will be double-sheathed 40-foot, 50-ton box cars; 1500 will be special double-sheathed 40-foot, 50-ton automobile cars for general service, including movement of grain in bulk, and 1000 are to be steel 50-foot, 50-ton automobile cars suitable also for general freight service.

The building of the special cars for the carrying of bulk grain will be of great benefit to the grain shippers of this section. These cars will be tight and moisture proof. It is planned to keep them in service for shuttle service back and forth from grain-loading stations to railroad terminal and shipping points at the time of year when grain is moving in its greatest bulk.

Statistics show that many communities use more than one motor vehicle per farm. The bureau of the census count shows 2,146,512 passenger cars on 1,949,264 farms, and 139,169 trucks on 131,551 farms. Over 30 per cent of all farms own cars, with two per cent owning trucks.

**CATTLE QUARANTINE STATION AT ASTORIA**

The second quarantine station for imported cattle in the United States is to be established at the Port of Astoria, Oregon, at the mouth of the Columbia river, an announcement by federal bureau of animal industry declares. Construction of the station is expected to begin at once, as a number of large importations of Jersey and Guernsey cattle are being planned by western dealers who expect to take advantage of the new quarantine establishment.

Heretofore all cattle brought into this country from abroad were landed at Athena, New Jersey. The fact that they had to be transported overland at high freight rates ran their cost up heavily for western purchasers and proved a depressing influence on the efforts of western stockmen and dairymen to improve their herds.

With a station to be established at Astoria, importations can be made direct from Europe by way of the Panama canal far more cheaply than when the animals were relayed overland by rail. The care which can be given the stock in the quiet southern waters will also be an advantage over rail shipping conditions. The shipping connections enjoyed by the Port of Astoria with all parts of the world and particularly with the British Isles and the continent, is assurance that adequate transportation will always be available for animals brought in at the new station.

Astoria, the most northwesterly city in Oregon, is also the center of what is rated as the richest dairy district in the west. Recent reports show that Clatsop county, Oregon, of which Astoria is the county seat, is the largest tubercular-free area in the world. The dairymen believe that the presence of imported cattle in numbers at Astoria will have a distinct influence in building up the quality of the herds throughout the entire west.

At least one considerable importation is already under way. About 25 head of horses and 100 head of Jerseys and Guernseys are to be imported at once for A. C. Raby of Portland, Oregon, according to Clifford F. Reid of the Great Northwestern Livestock association.

(Ed. Note: Columbia county cattlemen will be interested in the above announcement as many head of Jerseys and Guernseys have been imported direct from the island to this county.)
