#### COMMUNITY CHURCHES IN THE stance: NORTHWEST.

Reports from almost every quarter of the United States reveal that the number of community churches muitiplies rapidly. Evidence of the progress of the thovement is presented by the Pacific northwest. The community churches in Oregon and in association of such charches has been formed, and in March hold its first annual meeting at Portland, Oregon
