From present indications there will be much more logging in Clatsop county this coming summer than for some years past. Recently a company was organized in San Francisco with plenty of capital, to purchase timber land in the vicinity of Astoria. Many timber claims were bought up. It is the intention of this company to place its mill in operation immediately. The land owned by the company is situated along Young's river. The mill will be located in the timber, and the lumber will be flumed down to deep water.

With the coming of spring there is considerable discussion as to what the coming season's fashion may bring about in the way of hats. Not all the voters of this county, perhaps, are aware of the fact that before you go to the polls again to cast your ballot it will be necessary for you to be registered in order to be a qualified elector. The Harmon registration bill introduced at the regular session of the late legislature became a law, and it is now in full force and effect. As we interpret the law a registering official will be in each precinct at a specified time to receive your name, age, occupation, height, weight, color of hair and eyes, previous occupation, place of birth, whether a naturalized citizen or not, and a few other little points concerning appearance and character, just to make sure you are entitled to the right of suffrage in this big country of ours, and official to be a person authorized to administer an oath, and if you fail to present yourself for registration you will probably be denied the privilege to exercise your cherished prerogative at the next general election.

This is an age of lodges and fraternal societies, and it is a well known fact that St. Helens is no exception. The size of the coast. At the recent session of the legislature many important changes were made in the game laws of the state, and sportsmen will do well to note the changes, for going on their pleasure excursions. Deer are protected from November 1st to July 15th; they are not to be hunted with dogs; cannot be killed for market, and are not to be hunted one hour after sunset or one hour before sunrise. Spotted fawns are not to be killed at all while beaver are protected for seven months of twenty years. Mongolian or Chinese pheasants can be hunted only during the month of October and only fifteen in one day can be killed by one person. Hunting upon farms of growing or standing grain without the permission of the owner strictly prohibited. Game laws by fines ranging all the way from \$15 to \$500, or imprisonment of from 10 to 900 days. Game wardens are appointed in every section whose duty it is to see that these laws are not violated.

From a source of thorough reliability we learn that Frank Dow, of Oak Island, has purchased a bicycle for his own use.
