CHAPTER XXII.—Continued.

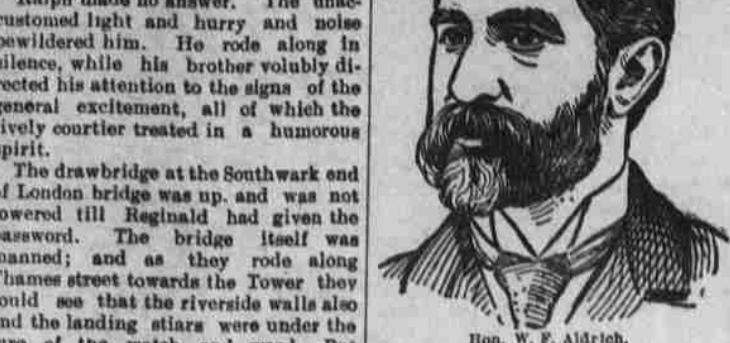
