CALL FOR BIDS ON COUNTY ROAD WORK.

Notice is hereby given by the undersigned, the County Road Master for the County of Columbia, Oregon, that bids in writing will be received by the County Clerk of said County of Columbia, Oregon, at St. Helens, Oregon, on the 15th day of May, 1904, on the heretofore described road work. Each bid must be accompanied by cash for twice the amount of the bid, as is required by law. The County Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

ROAD DISTRICT NO. 14.

Beginning at the first bridge below A. H. Lewis's residence on the Pittsburg and Mist road, and to extend toward Mist as far as the special tax money will permit, the road is to be graded 24 feet wide, with a rise of 11 inches to the center, and with drain cuts on each side of the road, and to be gravelled a depth of eight inches ten feet wide in center of road.

Beginning at the west end of the bridge across the Nehalem River at Pittsburg, and to extend toward Vernonia as far as the special tax money will permit, the road is to be graded 24 feet wide, with a rise of 11 inches to the center, and with drain cuts on each side of the road, and to be gravelled a depth of eight inches ten feet wide in center of road.

Beginning on the line between Road Districts Nos. 14 and 15, on the river road from Pittsburg to Vernonia, and to extend toward Pittsburg as far as the special tax money will permit, the road is to be graded 24 feet wide, with a rise of 11 inches to the center, and with drain cuts on each side of the road, and to be gravelled a depth of eight inches ten feet wide in center of road.

Beginning at the first stake north of the Rock Creek Bluff, on the Vernonia and Keizer road, marked with the following portions are to be cross laid with puncheon not less than nine feet long and four inches thick, from stake 1 to stake 2, 19 rods; from stake 2 to stake 4, 4 rods; from stake 4 to stake 5, 12 rods; from stake 5 to stake 12, 12 rods; from stake 12 to stake 13, 23 rods; and from stake 13 to a distance as far as the special tax money will permit, the road is to be graded a depth of eight inches ten feet wide.

Before the puncheons are laid the road bed is to be raised at least four inches. The stumps will be blown out by the Road Supervisor. Bids will be received for 20 rods of section.
