BETTER BOOKS SECURED AT LOWER PRICES.

The State Text-book Commission has announced the list of text-books adopted for use in the High Schools of the state for the ensuing six years. More than half the book are new adoptions.

The list, with exchange and retail prices, follows:

Speaking of the selections, a member of the commission said: 'We had before us several times as many books as we had six years ago and a much better lot of books from which to select. The publishing houses made a special effort to secure adoptions in Oregon and submitted for our consideration the latest and best books they had. Several series of books were offered. The first time they were offered anywhere. A number of the books adopted are of the 1907 edition, and are the best to be had on the subjects. There is scarcely any textbook good enough to maintain superiority for six years, and it is not at all surprising that we should find in 1907 books much better than those adopted in 1901.'

'The prices named are entirely satisfactory and must be considered remarkably low in view of the fact that the cost of material and labor has advanced 40 per cent in six years, yet we are getting our books under the old plan for less money than under the adoption. Keen competition, particularly by small publishing houses putting out new books, has kept prices down. Modern methods in printing and binding has given us better books from the standpoint of workmanship.'
