## GRANGE CONVENTION.

Meets at Clatskanie and Elects Delegates to State Grange.

Convention called to order at 1:30 p. m.

James Barr, of Clatskanie Grange was unanimously elected chairman.

E. H. Flagg, of Goble Grange was unanimously elected secretary.

The chair appointed the following committee on credentials; Wm Rose of Natal Grange, R. P. Burns of Beaver Valley Grange, M. P. Young of Cedar Grove Grange.

Delegates to the State convention were chosen as follows:

J. G. Pringle, R. A. Lovelace, B. A. Legg.

The delegates were given the privilege of naming their alternates and the choice was made as follows:

John F. Cheldelin, R. P. Burns, W. J. Fullerton.

The choice of alternates was ratified by the convention.

The following preamble and resolutions were offered by E. H. Flagg:

Whereas, the people of this country, through their State Legislatures, have frequently petitioned the National Congress to submit to the voters an amendment to the federal Constitution providing for the election of United States Senators by direct vote of the people, and the United States Senate has always approved of such action; and

Whereas, the Republican Legislature of the State of Oregon, by an almost unanimous vote submitted to the people the law known as the direct primary law, containing Statement No. 1, whereby the voters are permitted to express their choice for United States Senator, and the signers of said statement are in honor bound to abide by such expression of opinion; therefore be it

Resolved, That this convention heartily indorse Statement No. 1 and its members urge upon all Patrons of Husbandry in Columbia County and elsewhere that they support for nomination only such candidates as sign Statement No. 1. The resolution was unanimously adopted. Convention adjourned.

### Pillow Ticks.

The brown, spotted condition of pillow ticks is really grease and dirt that wear through the ticks. Unbleached muslins slips put over the ticks save the pillows a great deal. They may be removed and washed.

### Chili Con Carne from Leftovers.

A savory and economical way of using any kind of cold roast meat: Cut meat into small, square pieces. Dredge well with flour and warm milk, pepper and salt. Fry out some of the fat pieces and in this fry until light brown one large onion, cut up fine. Add the meat and stir well together. Pour over it enough water to cover, and add one can of pimientos cut up fine. Place on the back of the stove and simmer for three or four hours. The gravy should be a rich, reddish brown. Add paprika if you wish it hot.
