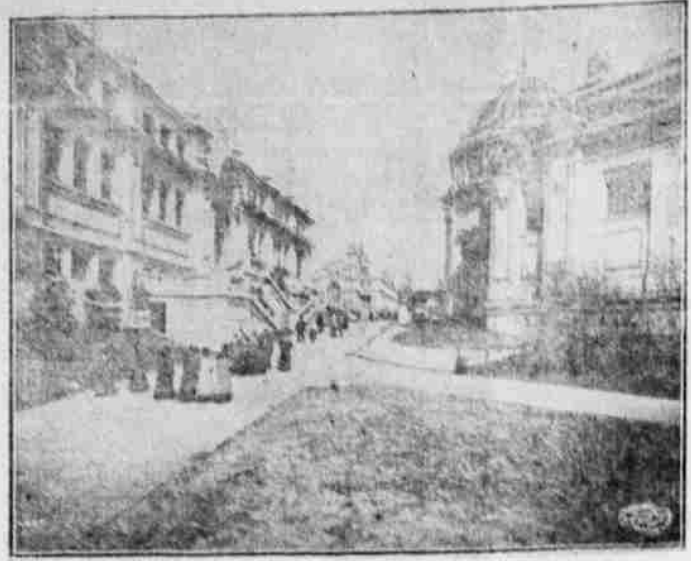
VOICE OF SPRING.

The stream, in onward course did stir, That Spring is coming, the joyous Spring.

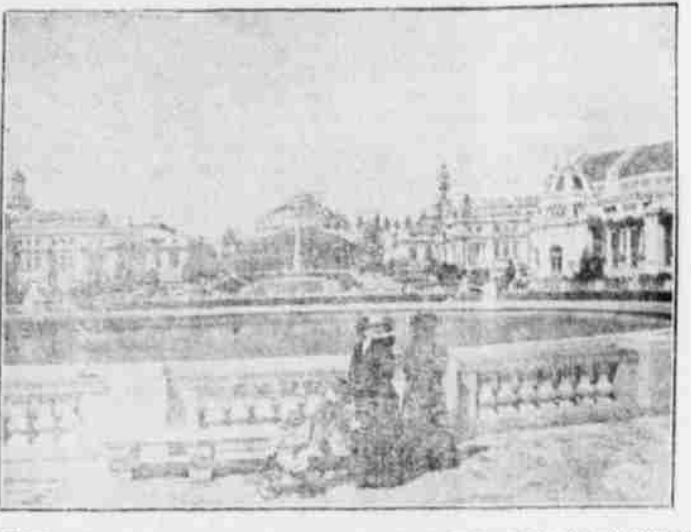
With all its birds and pretty flowers, With all its sweet, refreshing showers.
