TIME TO MAKE GOOD

It is several weeks since the Portland Evening Telegram made the assertion that a corrupt combination existed between the editor of the Mist and officials of Columbia County, and that if they had their just deserts they would not now be living in St. Helens (which can only be taken to mean that the proper place for said officials and the editor is the penitentiary). Then came the statement of the Telegram that "There is a duty which the press of Portland owes the public, and that is to expose the condition of affairs in Columbia County."

The Telegram is read in every city in the State, and this statement will, of course, have weight. People are justified in believing it, and therefore, if it is untrue, the good name of the county has been snatched and its officials have been unjustly stigmatized as criminals. If, on the other hand, the statement is not true, the people of this county have a right to know the facts. No decent editor would make such accusations without being able to prove them. Libel is a criminal offense, and justly so. Newspapers are liable to make mistakes, and the Telegram editor, guaranteeing under the exposure made by the Mist of its fake dispatch during the Margatroyd trial, may have made statements he believed to be true. He has had ample time to retract or to make good.

Who are the corrupt officials of Columbia County and in what way are they "hooked up" with the editor of the Mist? At the present time suspicion rests upon all. It is not time for the Telegram to "make good" its charges or have the decency to admit its mistake and apologize.

HOP PICKING

When the editor of the Oregonian intimates that hop picking is anything but hard work it must be supposed that he is speaking theoretically and not from actual experience. The hop growers have no use for the class of people who go into the fields either for fun or for their health. They want men, women and children who will put in from ten to twelve hours every day pulling hops as fast as they can make their hands go. It is healthful work, honest work, and reasonably clean work—but it's work all the time. The Oregonian says "Women can make their fingers fly in gathering this most delectable of harvests without losing their charm." It is tough on the simplicity. Hop picking is very hard upon a woman's hands and wrists, invariably scratching and staining them. If the object of the article is to induce a lot of Portland's society butterflies to work in the fields we hope it will succeed. They will know the real meaning of the word work, and it will be a substantial benefit to their health, but when they get home it will require a month's massaging, pumping and anointing before they will get rid of the scars, bruises and stains that attend this delightful occupation.
