

COUNTY COURT

In the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Columbia County.

Be it remembered, that a regular term of the County Court of the state of Oregon, for Columbia County was begun and held at the Court House in the city of St. Helens, in said County and State, on Wednesday the 4th day of May, 1910, the same being the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court, when were present: H. H. West, Commissioner; Hon. W. K. Tichenor, Commissioner; W. A. Harris, Clerk; M. White, Sheriff. Due proclamation being made the following proceedings were had:

Report of Viewers on Thos. Morris road:

On this day the report of the Viewers was read in open Court the first time.

Report of Viewers on J. B. Duncan road:

On this day the report of the viewers was read in open Court the first time.

Report of Viewers on F. L. Clark road:

On this day the report of the Viewers was read in open Court the first time.

Report of Viewers on John McAdam road:

On this day the report of the viewers was read in open Court the first time.

Matter of County Warrants more than 7 years old prior to July 1, 1910:

On this day the Clerk presents a certified list of all county warrants more than 7 years old prior to July 1st, 1910, which have not been presented for payment and have not been paid, showing the amount of each of said warrants, to whom issued, and date of issuance, whereupon it is ordered by the court that the said list be published in the official county paper stating that if said warrants are not presented for payment within sixty days from the first day of July, 1910, they will be cancelled, and payment thereof will be refused.

Matter of change of Boundaries and names of election precincts:

On this day this matter coming on for hearing and the Court being advised in the matter, it is ordered by the Court that the name of Auburn Precinct be, and the same is hereby changed to Vernonia Precinct, and that all of the land as bounded and described by the boundaries of Auburn precinct shall be embraced in, and constitute the precinct of Vernonia.

Nehalem Precinct to Mist Precinct:

And it is further ordered by the Court that all of the land embraced within the boundaries of Nehalem Precinct be and the same is included within the boundaries of Mist Precinct, and that the name of said Nehalem Precinct be and the same is hereby changed to the name of Mist Precinct.

And it is further ordered by the Court that new election precincts be established and the boundaries changed as follows to-wit:

RAINIER PRECINCT.

Commencing at a point in the channel of the Columbia River where the one-half section line of section 16 T. 7 N. R. 2 West would intersect said channel if extended North, thence South on the half section line of sections 16, 21, 28, and 33 to the Township line, thence east on the township line to the channel of the Columbia River, thence down said river to the place of beginning.

MORCK'S PRECINCT.

Beginning at a point in the channel of the Columbia River where the one-half section line of section 16, T. 7 N. R. 2 West would intersect said channel if extended north, thence south on the half section line of sections 16, 21, 28 and 33 to the township line, thence west 1/2 mile, thence south one mile, thence west one mile, thence south one mile, thence west one mile to the Township line, thence north on the Township line three miles, thence west 1/2 mile, thence north one-half mile, thence west three-fourths mile, thence north to the channel of the Columbia River, thence up the channel of said river to the place of beginning.

ST. HELENS PRECINCT.

Beginning at a point in the channel of the Columbia River where the half section line of section 16 T. 5 N. R. 1 West, if extended would intersect said channel, thence west on said half section line through sections 16, 17 and 18 to the Township line, thence south on the Township line three miles, thence east on the half-section line of sections 31 and 32 to the west line of the F. A. Lemont D. L. C., thence south on said D. L. C. to the south west corner, thence east on the south line of D. L. C. to the north west corner of the H. M. Kighton D. L. C., thence south on the west line of said Kighton D. L. C. to the Thos. H. Smith D. L. C., thence southwest on the north line of the Smith D. L. C. to the northwest corner of said Smith D. L. C., thence southeast on the west line of said Smith D. L. C. to the intersection of the south line of sec. 9 S. 3 N. E. 1 West, thence east on the south line of said Sec. 9 to the center of the Willamette slough, thence up said slough to the north line of section 16 T. 3 N. R. 1 West, thence east on the north line of said section 16 to the northeast corner corner thereon, thence south to the county line, thence east one mile, thence north one-half mile, thence east to the center of the channel of the Columbia River, thence down the center of the main channel of the Columbia River to the place of beginning.

WOLFE'S PRECINCT.

Beginning at the northeast corner of section 25 T. 4 N. R. 2 west, thence west

3 miles, thence north one mile, thence west 7 miles, thence south 2 miles, thence west one-half mile, thence south 3 miles, thence east to the west boundary of the Achilles D. L. C. in Tp. 4 N. R. 1 West, thence north on the west boundary of the Achilles D. L. C. to the north west corner thereof, thence east on the north boundary of the Achilles and Stevens D. L. C. to the northwest corner of the Posey Williams D. L. C., thence southeast along the west boundary line of said Williams D. L. C. to the southwest corner of the said Williams D. L. C., thence north-easterly along the southern boundary line of the Williams D. L. C. and Thos. H. Smith D. L. C. to the intersection of the south boundary line of section 9 T. 4 N. R. 1 west, thence north on the western boundary line of said Smith D. L. C. to the northwest corner thereof, thence easterly on the north line of said Smith D. L. C. to the west line of the H. M. Kighton D. L. C., thence northerly on the west boundary line of said Kighton D. L. C. to the F. A. Lemont D. L. C., thence westerly on south boundary line of Lemont D. L. C. to southwest corner thereof, thence north on the west line of said claim to the half section line of section 32 T. 5 N. R. 1 west, thence west on said half section line to the Township line, thence north on the Township line to the place of beginning.

WARRER PRECINCT.

Beginning at a point in the Willamette Slough where the section line between section 9 and 16 intersects said slough, T. 4 N. R. 1 West, thence west on said section line to the west boundary of the Thos. H. Smith D. L. C., thence southerly following the southern boundary line of the Smith & Williams D. L. C. to the southwest corner of the Posey Williams D. L. C., thence northwest along the west line of the Williams D. L. C. to the northwest corner, thence west along the north line of the Stevens and Achilles D. L. C. to the northwest corner of the Achilles D. L. C., thence south on the west line of said Achilles D. L. C. to the section line between section 7 and 18 T. 4 N. R. 1 west, thence west to the northwest corner of section 15 T. 4 N. R. 3 west, thence south 3 miles, thence east to the west boundary line of the David A. Cloninger D. L. C., thence northeast to the northwest corner of the said Cloninger D. L. C., thence southeast on the Cloninger D. L. C. and H. S. Fullerton D. L. C. lines to the southeast corner of the said Fullerton D. L. C., thence north on the east line of said Fullerton D. L. C. to the section line between sections 30 and 31 T. 4 N. R. 1 West, thence east to the center of the Willamette Slough, thence down the center of said slough to the place of beginning.

SCAPOOSE PRECINCT.

Beginning at a point on the section line between 27 and 34 T. 4 N. R. 1 West where said line intersects the center of the Willamette Slough, thence west on said section line to the northeast corner of the R. S. Fullerton D. L. C., thence south on the east line of said Fullerton D. L. C. to the southeast corner of said claim; thence northwest along the boundary lines of the said Fullerton D. L. C. and the D. L. C. of David A. Cloninger to the northwest corner of said Cloninger D. L. C., thence southwest on the west line of said Cloninger D. L. C. to the section line between sections 25 and 36 T. 4 N. R. 2 West, thence west to the northwest corner of section 31 T. 4 N. R. 3 west; thence south one mile; thence east 4 miles; thence south 2 miles; thence east 2 miles; thence south 1 mile; thence east 3 miles; thence south 1 mile; thence east 6 miles; thence north 2 miles; thence west to the center of the Willamette Slough; thence down said Slough to the place of beginning.

Whereupon Court adjourned until Thursday May 5th, 1910.

Thursday May 5th, 1910, Court came pursuant to adjournment. All members being present; due proclamation being made the following proceedings were had:

Report of Viewers on Thos. Morris road:

On this day this matter coming to be heard upon the second reading of the report of the viewers, a remonstrance having been filed with a greater number of names than contained on the petition, and the Court after duly considering said petition and remonstrance, orders that the petition be, and the same is hereby denied.

Report of Viewers on J. B. Duncan road:

On this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the second reading of the report of the viewers, and it appearing to the Court that John Duncan has filed a claim for damages in the sum of \$1000 and Mrs. E. M. Watts in the sum of \$300 and the viewers having allowed J. B. Duncan damages in the sum of \$50, and that the said road is not of sufficient public utility to warrant the allowance of claims for damages, it is therefore ordered that said petition be, and the same is denied.

Report of Viewers on John McAdam road:

Now on this day this matter coming on for hearing upon the second reading of the report of the Viewers, which report was publicly read on two different days of this term of Court, said Viewers reporting damages as follows: Fritz Anderson \$25, John Carlton \$50, W. R. Dotson \$40, and Thos. A. Smith \$100, and claims for damages having been filed as follows: W. D. Dotson \$100, Thos. A. Smith \$200, and the Court

being advised in the matter allows the claims for damages in the following sums: Fritz Anderson, \$25, John Carlton, \$50; W. R. Dotson, \$40 and Thos. A. Smith, \$100. It is ordered by the Court that said report, survey, profile and plat be recorded in suitable books kept for that purpose, and from thenceforth said road shall be a public highway, and it is further ordered that the supervisor in whose district said road is located shall open the same for public travel, and it is further ordered by the Court that the Clerk draw warrants upon the road fund in payment of the claims for damages as herein allowed.

Report of Viewers on F. L. Clark road:

On this day this matter coming on for hearing upon the second reading of the report of the viewers, which report was publicly read upon two different days of this term of Court, said viewers reporting damages to the place of John Zoller in the sum of \$75, and no remonstrance or petition for damages having been filed, and the Court being advised that such road would be of public utility, and the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, it is therefore ordered by the Court that said report, survey, profile and plat be recorded in suitable books kept for that purpose, and from thenceforth said road shall be a public highway, and it is further ordered that the road supervisor in whose district said road is located shall open the same for public travel.

Matter of bounty on wild animals:

On this day the Clerk presents to the Court the front paw of the animals as described in claims No. 27 and 28 amounting to \$6.50, which claims are approved by the Court.

Matter of petition of N. A. Hall et. al. for County Road:

On this day it is ordered by the Court that the Viewers be instructed to complete the survey of the said road as petitioned for, and that they meet at Clatskanie on May 10th, 1910, and proceed to view, survey and locate said road as heretofore directed.
