ORDINANCE NO. 115

An ordinance establishing the "Strand Improvement District," describing the boundaries thereof; ordering improvements therein; apportioning the expense thereof among the owners of the property affected, and providing the manner of the collection of same.

The City of St. Helens does ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That all that portion of the City of St Helens described as lying between the South boundary line of Lot 14 in Block 10 and the North boundary line of Lot 18 in block 11 fronting and abutting on the "Strand", and all that portion of the strand lying directly East of said above described property, be and is hereby established as the "Strand Improvement District".

Sec. 2. That a portion of the Strand in said City and being that portion described in Sec. 1, hereof, 80 feet in width from the Eastern boundary line of Block 10 and 11 of said City be improved as follows: all abstructions be removed; cuts and fills be made to comply with the grade thereof as established by the Council; After all cuts and fills have been made the top to be covered with crushed rock and screenings, then rolled until a complete macadamized roadway be constructed.

Sec. 3. That the committee on Streets of the Council are hereby authorized to employ an engineer

to set the grade stakes and provide specifications and plans for such improvements.

Sec. 4. That the Recorder is hereby instructed to advertise these bids for the improvements there provided for in accordance with the plans and specifications to be prepared by the engineer and that an advertisement run for two consecutive issues of the "Oregonian" and that the Council reserve the right to reject any or all bids.

Sec. 5. That the cost of all improvements, including assessment, and publication, assessed to the property described in said "Strand Improvement District" and the same, when apportioned, be collected by the Treasurer in manner as provided in ordinance No. 10 of the City of St Helens.

Sec. 6. In as much as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of St Helens in this, that the street at present impassable, and in a deplorable condition and in as much that it is necessary to properly do so it is necessary to enact this ordinance. Now therefore an emergency is declared and this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor. Approved Dec. 11th 1911.
