It is generally conceded that the opening of the Panama Canal will cause a wonderful growth in business and population on the Pacific Coast. It is now confidently expected that the big canal will be in operation during the Fall of 1913, nearly a year in advance of the time originally fixed for its completion. When this great boom strikes the Pacific Coast the Lower Columbia River country, between Portland and Astoria, will receive its full share without doubt, as no other part of the Coast is situated more advantageously for commerce and manufacturing enterprises than this. The timber supply of this district is greater than in any other district of equal size in the United States. The manufacturing sites along the banks of the great Columbia River cannot be excelled in the world. The soil and climate along the River for fruit raising and small farming is ideal.

There is room for 10 times the number of people to make homes in Columbia and Clatsop counties on the Oregon side and Clarke, Wiltz, Wakiakum and Pacific counties on the Washington side, now live in these counties.

Everything indicates that this section of the country will develop, within the next few years, as it has never done before and that a wave of prosperity will strike along the Columbia River which will last for many years.

College graduates predominate in the enrollment of students for the short course at the Oregon Agricultural College. The greater number being graduates of eastern universities and institutions of higher education. Representatives of Harvard, Yale, Cornell, West Point, Randolph-Macomb College, Va., Oberlin College, the state universities of Pennsylvania, Virginia, Minnesota, Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Oregon, Washington, Stanford University, and a host of lesser institutions are enrolled. About half are taking horticulture, and as many dairying and animal husbandry.

Among the students are men of varied profession, including engineers, bookkeepers, landscape gardeners, clerks, express agents, travelling salesmen, stockmen, ministers, bankers, pharmacists, trained nurses, cooks, photographers, general farmers, fruitmen, dairymen, bookkeepers, butter makers, orchard superintendents, farm managers, insurance agents, merchants, confectioners, college professors, lumbermen, carpenters and homekeepers.

Some of the students come from abroad, from Japan, Switzerland, Germany, England and British Columbia, while others are from the states of Virginia, New York, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Michigan, Illinois, Minnesota, Nebraska, New Mexico, California and Washington. The greater number are,

Many thousands of acres of land are represented in their holdings, one student having a farm of 1,000 acres in central Oregon and others having from 200 to 500 acres. Most of those whose farms contain less than 100 acres have orchard properties.

The college will be glad, whenever possible, to send an expert to confer with the association or individual as to the construction of a manufacturing plant or erection of a small home plant.

No 6, 6 mills; dist No 13, 2.5 mills; dist No 33, 4.5 mills; dist No 38, 3 mills; dist No 40, .2 mills; dist No 49, .1 mill; dist No 55, .2 mills.
