The English Vessel "Lord Templeton" arrived at the St. Helens Mill Dock this week in tow of the Steamer Fenwick. She was towed all the way from Frisco to St. Helens and the trip was made in 68 hours. It will take about 30 days to load this vessel here with 2,000,000 feet of St. Helens Lumber for shipment to Australia.

McCormick Lumber Yards

The McCormick Lumber Company have recently completed docks and yards in San Diego, Cal and we take the following from the San Diego Union, which will be of interest to St. Helens people:

With one coast steamer and two coasting steamers alongside, and another coaster in the stream waiting for a berth late yesterday, the McCormick wharf was the busiest pier in the harbor. A double track system and double Y for switching from the dock, enable the small wharf to handle a tremendous amount of traffic. Practically every available foot of space on the dock is in use.

The pier was built strong enough to bear the weight of the heaviest drive on the Santa Fe system. It stands in water that is deep—15 feet—required for the ordinary vessels.
