Wednesday, Feb. 17th 1912. 6th judicial day. Court came pursuant to adjournment. Officers all present. Due proclamation being made the following proceedings were had. Matter of appointment of supervisor for R D No 6.

On this day this matter coming on for consideration, and the Court being advised in the premises, it is ordered by the Court that J E Johnson, be and he is hereby appointed Road Supervisor for Road District No. 6, for the year 1912, and until his successor shall have been duly appointed and qualified.

Matter of bids for Special Road work in road district No 3.

On this day this matter coming on for consideration and it appearing to the Court that no bids have been filed or presented herein. It is ordered by the Court that said special road work, as advertised shall be performed by U S Spain, supervisor of said district No 3, under the direction of the County Court.

Matter of petition for appointment of fair commissioner.

On this day this matter coming on for consideration on the petition of C E Lake for appointment as Fair Commissioner for the year 1912, and the Court being advised, it is ordered that said C E Lake be, and he is hereby appointed Fair Commissioner for Columbia County, for the year 1912.

Matter of application for license to keep Billard Saloon.

On this day it appearing to the Court that S R Milloy has paid to the Treasurer of Columbia County, the sum of \$25.00, and makes application for a license to keep a Billard Saloon, it is ordered by the Court that said petition be, and the same is hereby granted, and that license issue to said S R Milloy, to keep a billiard saloon in Columbia County, Oregon, for the period of six months.

Matter of Scalp bounty claim.

Matter of petition for change of voting place.
