And it satisfactorily appearing to the court from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required that twelve of said petitioners are legal freeholders of this county residing in the road district or districts of the proposed road and that a good and sufficient bond has been given and filed herein:
