That said improvement shall be made at the expense of the real property abutting upon said portion of Casneau Street aforesaid, and after the completion of said work the Common Council shall apportion the cost thereof to the several lots or fractions of lots abutting upon said improved portion of said Street, according to the value of such lots as determined by the last previous County assessment, and thereupon said Common Council shall formally declare said apportionment by ordinance and direct the Recorder to enter a statement thereof in the Docket of City Liens where the same shall become a Lien against the property so affected.
