The act contains a schedule of allowances for death, total perma-
nent disatifity and varous permnent disatuity and various perm
anent partial disabilities, and in yests the Commission, with au
thority to fix by reference to thority to fix by reference t.

An exception is made with re
spect to the payment of allow ances in monthly installments to this extent: The Commisssion is invested with authority in its discretion to pay over to a beneficiary who is or becomes a nonresident of the state a fump sum
equal to eauns to three.-fourths of the
present value of future installments, and also to a resident beneficiary a sum not greater than one-fourth of the present value futue installments. In the first case mentioned the claim of thereby extinguished, and in the second all subsequent monthly installments are proportionately reduced.
