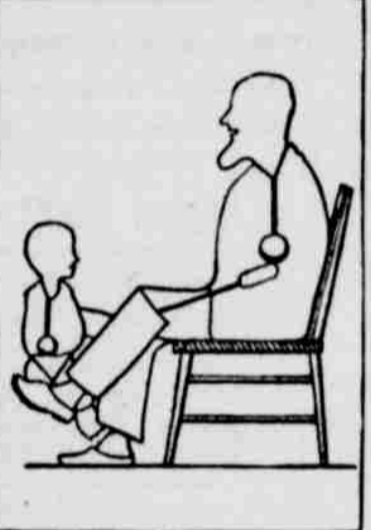

No. 1. Hoof showing prominent "frog," unutilized "bars," strong walls and cupped sole.

No. 2. Distortion of hoof caused by acute founder. The feet should be lifted quickly and evenly, and be set down squarely and firmly.

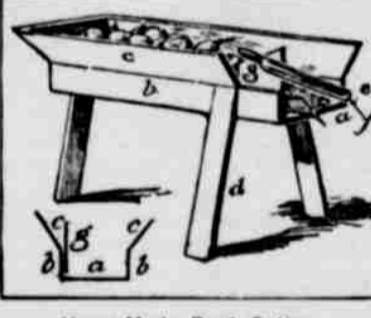
The hoofs should be ample in size, sound, smooth and symmetrical in shape. The hoof is a continuation of the skin of the parts above.
