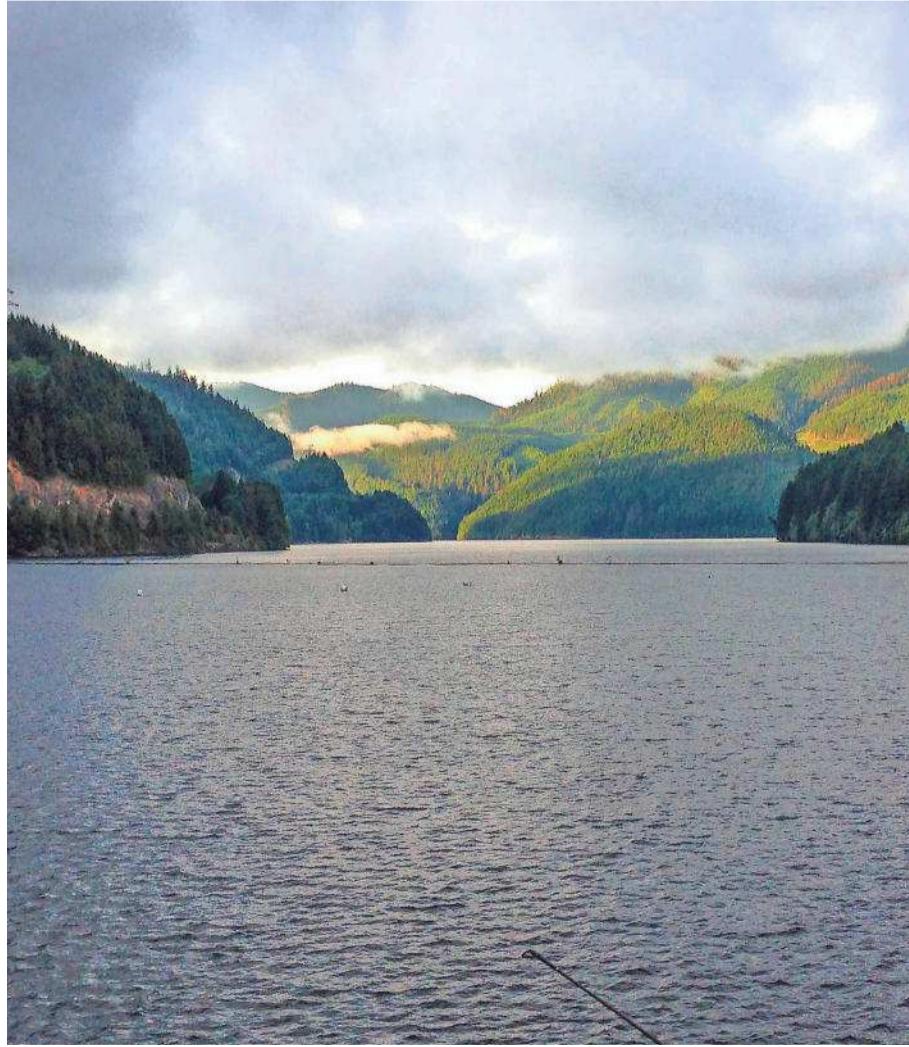

Clemans stressed that more rain will likely be needed. Although the Willamette Basin's snowpack, which is near normal, will help, Detroit Lake depends almost entirely on rainfall to fill.

"If it doesn't rain at all between now and mid-May, we can't guarantee that we'll reach the maximum elevation," Clemans said.

Clemans said Detroit Lake has only failed to reach or get very close to its summertime fill level twice in recent history, in 2001 and 2015.
