Family of missing hiker continues search efforts on Mt. Jefferson

The Marion County Sheriff's Office suspended its seven-day search for Riley Zickel on Saturday, but family members of the missing hiker are continuing the search near Mt. Jefferson and the surrounding wilderness.

More than 340 personnel dedicated about 5,000 hours to search the Willamette National Forest, Jefferson Park and Park Butte, but the sheriff's office called off the search for 21-year-old Zickel, a Portland resident and chemistry major at Lewis & Clark College, after "exhausting all available leads," said sheriff's office spokesman Lt. Chris Baldrige in a statement.

In a social media posting, Zickel's father thanked search and res-

cue personnel for their time and effort and said the family would hold fast

tipped of the sheriff's office on a possible location for Zickel—a crevasse on the Jefferson Glacier.

The Corvallis Mountain Rescue Team ascended Mt. Jefferson to check the crevasse, Baldrige said.

The search mission found no signs of Zickel, and the team turned back after a snowstorm hit the mountain.

The Zickel's case will remain open until he is found, and the sheriff's office will respond to any new information regarding his whereabouts.
