ABOUT RESTAURANT INSPECTIONS

This is a snapshot of the inspections conducted by the Marion and Polk County health departments.

Twice annually, licensed restaurants receive unannounced inspections that focus on food temperatures, food preparation practices, worker hygiene, dish-washing and sanitizing, and equipment and facility cleanliness.

Violations: Restaurant scores are based on a 100-point scale. Priority violations deduct 5 points, and priority foundation violations deduct 3 points. Violations recorded on consecutive inspections result in point deductions being doubled.

Scoring: Scores of 70 or higher are considered compliant. Restaurants scoring below 70 must be re-inspected within 30 days or face closure or other administrative action. Restaurants display a placard by the entrance to indicate whether they have passed their last inspection.

Food trucks, carts and trailers: Mobile food operators do not receive a numerical score. They are either approved to operate or not approved to operate.

■ Ready-to-eat food is not properly date-marked, specifically: No date marking of the food items walk-in refrigerator. Opened container of milk in walk-in – not date marked. **Point deduction: 3.**

■ Ambient air or water temperature measuring devices are not easily readable or not accurately or properly scaled, specifically: Thermometer on the grill drawers is not functioning correctly. **Point deduction: 3.**

Agenda Item #1: File Number AN-19-01 & PA-19-03 & PA-19-04. Annexation application to annex 148 Cambridge Avenue into the City Limits and zone the property R-1, Single Family Residential with a current partition application to divide the site into five parcels in two phases. The property is 89,215 square feet in area and is developed with a single family home. The partition would create five parcels with two parcels measuring 7,181 square feet in area, two parcels measuring 7,941 square feet in area, and one parcel measuring 55,520 square feet in area. Located on the south side of Princeton Avenue at 148 Cambridge Avenue, Marion County Assessor's Map 061W03AD, Tax Lot 00200. The application will be reviewed following the criteria found in Silverton Development Code section 4.10.140 & 4.3.140.

Agenda Item #2: File Number CU-19-01. Conditional Use application to construct an accessory structure 22.875 feet in height and in excess of 800 square feet at 772 Woodland Drive. Located on the western side of Woodland Drive at 772 Woodland Drive; Marion County Assessor's Map 071W03A Tax Lot 01100. The application will be reviewed following the criteria found in Silverton Development Code section 4.4.400

All interested persons and the general public will be given an opportunity to be heard relative to the application either by submitting material in writing to City Hall or providing oral testimony at the Public Hearing. Failure of an issue to be raised in a hearing, in person or by letter, or failure to provide enough detail to afford the decision maker an opportunity to respond precludes appeal to LUBA based on that issue.
